Directions: Cut apart the following word cards. Use them for the Affinity Mapping activity.

There are two ways of approaching this activity.

1. Option A is to give each of the student groups the entire set of 133 cards and have them sort all words. This is how the lesson is designed.
2. Option B is to create smaller subsets of word cards by dividing the full list into approximately 5 or six smaller sets of words. If you use option B, you will need to mix the cards thoroughly so that students will get a variety from throughout the full set.

The tribe has already organized these words into these categories. The words are already organized in the order of these categories, but the words are not labeled as such so that students can process them on their own. A copy of word list with the categories is provided in the next lesson. If students have difficulty categorizing the words in this lesson, suggest the following categories.
