Animals



Lesson Focus and Goals

This lesson focuses on the 8 Takelma animal words. Using the video, e-book, and PDF, students will be able to hear, say and read the words.

Materials Needed

- Takelma Animals Book (or e-book)
 - Animals PDF
 - Animals Pictures
 - Animals Class Video link
- (all materials/links to the materials can be found here on the site)

Learning Objectives

Students will be able to:

- say the 8 animal words.
- recognize the 8 animals when they hear them.
- read the 8 animals (those who can already read English).

Structure / Activity

1. Watch the Animals Class video. Follow along and participate as you go! Use the book to help you with the answers.
2. Go through the e-book. Make sure to use the audio, and repeat the words out loud.
3. Print out the PDF. Cut out the flashcards. Use the flash cards to practice the words.
4. Continue to practice these words to keep them in your vocabulary.

Additional Practice Activities

1. Teach someone you know the animal words. Use the materials such as the book and printed PDF.
2. Make a poster to hang in your house. Print real pictures of the animals out to use along side the illustrated ones, and use the poster to practice the words.


