WHAT THE EXPANDING HORIZONS YOUTH CENTER OFFERS

Activities for Youth Grades 3-12

The Center provides a nutritious snack and meal for after school participants. An education session is required of each student daily.

Staff will provide a learning activity when needed. Tutoring by staff and higher grade peers is available to assist with homework.

Staff communicates with teachers in our local schools to help provide a plan for each student needing extra assistance.



Our students have access to numerous laptops and computers with Wi-Fi to support their learning needs. Positive social interactions are modeled by staff and other peers in the Center. Cultural and STEAM activities along with an array of art and cooking projects are provided each day.

There is no cost to families for membership or any of the activities provided.



Transportation Provided

At this time, EHYC staff transports students from Coffenberry Middle School, Canyonville, Tri-City Elementary, and Myrtle Creek Elementary School in a 15-passenger van provided by the Cow Creek Tribe. Transportation from South Umpqua High School is provided by First Student busses. Arrangements can be made from Riddle and Days Creek Schools as needed.
